The British 10K London Sunday 1st July 2007

The Dyspraxia Foundation has secured places in the British 10k Road Race for men and women scheduled to take place on Sunday morning 1st July 2007 in London. Last year 20 runners from the Dyspraxia Foundation raised over £34,000 —they and their families also had a most enjoyable day out. Will you join this select group and take part in this year's race? A 6.2 mile run which you can do at your own pace and raise some much needed funds for the Foundation.

Starting on Piccadilly at Hyde Park Corner, the route passes the legendary Hard Rock Café, St James' Palace, Trafalgar Square, Somerset House, The magnificent St Paul's Cathedral, The Millennium Bridge, Blackfriars, The London Eye, Big Ben, Westminster Abbey, Banqueting House and Royal Horse Guards before finishing on Whitehall at the Cenotaph and Downing Street.

This unique event, is strictly limited to 20,000 runners with the majority of places only available through a registered charity and is an ideal opportunity for the Foundation to raise much needed funds whilst increasing awareness of dyspraxia. Places will be allocated on a 'first come, first served' basis and as the number is limited we are requesting a £30 deposit for each entrant (this deposit can be deducted from the total sponsorship raised). Each entrant will receive a Race T-Shirt, Discount Vouchers and entry into a prize draw.
